

## Iceland

**Distinctive Features:** Social protection system similar to other Nordic nations; universalism

### Maternity / Parental Leave

Benefit	Cash benefit and job-protected leave
Eligibility Criteria	Universal for all parents, at the time of childbirth or adoption, with at least 6 months consecutive employment prior to claiming (Mothers must take the first two weeks after birth.)
Duration of Leave	3 months for each parent and another 3 months for either
Compensation Rate	80 percent of prior wages
Other	Paid sick leave to care for an ill child under age 13 for up to 13 weeks a year.

### Early Childhood Education and Care

Age Group Served	0 – 5
Eligibility Criteria	Universal; dependent on classroom space
Fees	Income-related fees
Locus of Care	Centers, family day care homes
Funding Strategies	Govt., parent fees
Access/Coverage (%)	Ages 0 – 5 (58%): almost 93% of 3- 4- 5-year olds, 73% of 2-year olds, 44% of 1-year olds
